McCarthy Family Scholarship

The Kewanee Hospital Foundation is pleased to offer the McCarthy Family Scholarship for students pursuing a Registered Nurse (RN) designation. The scholarship is in honor of Miss Harriet McCarthy and her parents, Harry and Florence B. McCarthy. Miss McCarthy was a mathematics instructor at Kewanee High School for 38 years, retiring in 1971. Mr. McCarthy was a products engineer for the Walworth Company in Kewanee in the early 1900s. Their family was an integral part of the Kewanee community for many years. The Kewanee Hospital Foundation honors their lasting citizenship and their commitment to higher learning through this McCarthy Family Scholarship opportunity.

General Information

One McCarthy Family Scholarship recipient will be chosen annually. The maximum scholarship award is \$8,000, payable over the course of the recipient's education until their RN designation is obtained. \$1000 will be awarded for each semester of full-time coursework.

Applications are due to the Kewanee Hospital Marketing & Development office on Thursday, April 1, 2010.

An application form is attached. The scholarship recipient will be notified of their award by Tuesday, June 1, 2010.

The McCarthy Family Scholarship is open to anyone with a primary residence in Henry, Stark, or Bureau Counties who is enrolled in an accredited RN program, either at an associates, diploma, or bachelors degree level (potentially 2, 3 and 4 years of study respectively.)

Each scholarship recipient would be required to work for Kewanee Hospital for a minimum length of time following completion of his or her RN program. The length of this commitment would correlate with the amount of assistance received. (i.e. Two years of assistance at \$2,500 per year would result in two years of work with the Hospital, etc.) Scholarship recipients would complete an Educational Support Agreement, which contains details of the program.

The McCarthy Family Scholarship Selection Committee consists of the Director of Marketing & Development, the Chief Nursing Officer at Kewanee Hospital, a member of the educational community and one community member selected at large.
