GENERAL ASSEMBLY SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The General Assembly Scholarship is a tuition waiver for one academic year, including summer school, to any of the State of Illinois four-year universities. Students may re-apply each year, but recipients may only receive the waiver for two years.

A student may apply to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for more comprehensive coverage. A student may not accept both ISAC and the General Assembly Scholarship, as they are both tuition waivers; however, a student may accept both a General Assembly Scholarship and a Pell Grant.

To qualify, a student must be at least 16 years old, a legal resident of the 74th District, and accepted as a full-time student, undergraduate or graduate level.

Members of the Scholarship Committee are residents of the 74th District. The committee judges applicants on scholastic ability, activities and honors, financial need.
